Steven opened the meeting at 6:34 pm. No Chair yet.

Ray moved, Bill second, to approve the minutes of February 18, 2014. Passed unanimously.

Bill contacted the Air Force Civil Engineering Command's civilian consultant to see if progress was made on Mt. Horace Greeley site. She forwarded his email to the Air Force and will contact Bill with updates. Bill asked Mark Petrie of MDEQ if he heard from the Air Force and he had not. Ray contacted the Federal General Service Administration, but they have not returned his calls.

Bill researched deeds and found that Keweenaw County owns 80 acres not 59. Some discussion. Ray thinks the differences are based on commitment agreements. Ray also mentioned that Keweenaw Copper is not as interested in the Mt. Horace Greeley site as before due to their purchases at White Pine. Keweenaw County still has a five year lease with them for a building they are using there.

Michael brought four file boxes of Authority material to store at the County Courthouse. The material is from Marlin Wingard, the past Authority Chair. Ray will inform the County about the boxes.

Steven asked for public comment at 7:02 pm. There was no public comment.

Michael moved, Bill second, to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 pm. Passed unanimously.
