The letter seeks information from EGLE about determination of whether Neuvokas is continuing to violate rule 901, the non-token fines if the rule is being violated, informing the County about the status of installation of the required vertical stack, informing the County concerning the status of compliance with the Nuisance Minimization Plan for Odors, providing the County with information concerning the Status of Implementation of the third-party consultant's recommendations and that EGLE insist on strict compliance with the consent order and impose non-token fines for non-compliance with the consent order going forward.
