

In May 2025, the Keweenaw County Road Commission was awarded \$4,000 from Visit Keweenaw – Destination Development Fund. Destination Development is the process of investing in a community's infrastructure to make it better at attracting visitors and improving their experience. The road commission utilized the funds to purchase two wheelchair accessible picnic tables, six standard picnic tables constructed of recycled materials by Barco Products, and site signage. The two accessible picnic tables were placed at popular public beaches located in Bete Grise and Eagle River, both of which did not have accessible tables prior. KCRC graded and surfaced designated locations for these tables. The remaining six tables were placed at other popular county roadside parks that have seen increased usage in recent years.
