THE KEWEENAW HEARTLANDS AUTHORITY BOARD

On Monday, June 1, the Keweenaw County Board incorporated the Keweenaw Heartlands Recreational & Natural Resources Authority Board (Board). This new Board has five, publicly elected, non-partisan positions. Those elected will be responsible for the governance and management of the future Keweenaw Heartlands Community Forest. The Authority will also have the ability to own and protect other forestland in the County.

WHAT'S EXPECTED?

Those running for the Authority Board should care deeply about Keweenaw County's forests. They should be willing to build the new Board's capabilities and contribute time to preparation for future management of the Keweenaw Heartlands Community Forest.
