A motion to discuss The General Appropriations Resolution was made by The Supervisor and seconded by The Clerk. There was some discussion to clarify budget questions from the meeting held on February 11, 2021. There was a roll call vote and all members voted "aye". The Appropriations Resolution was passed and all copies were signed. The meeting was adjourned at 6:40 PM.

REGULAR MEETING

Supervisor Middlemis-Brown called the regular meeting of the Sherman Township Board to order on Thursday, February 11, 2021 at 6:40 PM after the Truth In Taxation Meeting. Other Board members attending were Treasurer Marilyn Kastelic, Clerk JT Reno, Trustee Frank Kastelic and Trustee Deneen Connell. There were also four community members and Melissa Davis from New Power Tour in attendance. The Treasurer made a motion to discuss the agenda, Trustee Connell seconded. All votes were "ayes". Melissa Davis from New Power Tour gave a short presentation about renewable energy in our area. There was no other public comment.

The minutes from the January 14, 2021 regular meeting were presented. The Clerk made a motion to discuss the minutes, The Treasurer seconded. There were no comments or additions, and all votes to approve were "ayes". Trustee Connell made a motion to approve and discuss expenditures, The Treasurer seconded. The Clerk stated that the power bills, bills from Whitewater for Bacti/WQP testing, a bill from Krans oil for fuel, and Board of Review member pay were added. There were no questions and all votes were "ayes."

The 2021-2040 Capital Improvement plan was discussed next. Tractor replacement, a metal roof for the community hall, park improvements, and insulation for the Fire Hall were discussed with input from the public. The Capital Improvement plan will be finalized in the next few months. Vacancy of the Sewer operator and Building/Grounds positions due to the retirement of R. Pieti in May was discussed. Putting ads in the paper, adjusting pay for the positions, and updating/posting the job descriptions were all recommended.

The Clerk mentioned that quarterly PFAS samples will need to be taken for the water system, greatly increasing the testing costs for the year.

There was no further business and the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 PM. The next Regular Meeting will be held in the Community hall at 6:30 PM on Thursday April 8, 2021.
